Re: Beatrice McGuire,

I received a registered letter from Beatrice McGuire on Friday (copy attached), I am sure, by now, that both you and the other directors will have received your own copies.

Given the difficulties between us and the fact that I was not permitted to speak to Cheryl O'Brien on Friday it seems unlikely that I would be invited to attend a board meeting to discuss this issue. Accordingly I was left with no alternative but to personally respond (copy attached for your information) to her letter without the benefit of discussion with the other named directors.

I deeply regret the difficulties that seem to be piling up for you and hope that this particular incident will be resolved quickly and with grace.

Before closing I will say this. Whatever you may choose to think or say to others I withdrew from your organization because I did not like the way you sought to treat me.
